Working with your *Carriere*[®] Motion[™] Appliance

At the start of treatment today, your orthodontist installed the *Carriere®* Motion Appliance.

The *Carriere* Motion Appliance is designed to move your teeth in a consolidated way to help you achieve a correct bite. With the proper wearing of your rubber bands, this appliance will keep you from having to wear headgear or other bulky appliances later in your treatment.

The *Carriere* Motion Appliance is able to handle normal chewing of food and drink but like all appliances if proper care is not taken then the appliance may become detached from your teeth.

It may be suggested that your rubber bands be removed prior to eating and drinking.

Carriere Motion Reminders



If you have been instructed to remove your rubber bands prior to eating meals, then you should place new rubber bands in your mouth. Carry your rubber bands with you at all times.



If your appliance becomes detached from your tooth, it is not an emergency but you should call your orthodontist during normal business hours to schedule an appointment to get it repaired.



As with any orthodontic appliance inside the mouth, there may be times of discomfort or irritation. If you have a concern, please call your orthodontist and ask for help.





Remember to keep all scheduled appointments with your doctor to help monitor your progress


